**Daramola Adesuyi Foundation (DAF)** is a community-based Non-Governmental Organization (NGO) founded in 2022 with a mission to inspire, empower, and connect people through effective mentorship and strategic solutions to enable them to change their world. DAF supports outreaches and programmes that work to address the areas of Education, Health and Welfare. DAF is presently situated in Ondo State, South West Nigeria.



# How We Impact

## **Community Leadership Learning**

DAF Community Leadership training is aimed at emerging young community leaders. DAF through this leadership training aims to provide a platform for emerging leaders to share best practices of effective leadership in their various fields of interest and expertise.

## **Educational Support Scheme**

The educational support scheme is the key rehabilitative area that will be employed by DAF in restoring hope and nurturing the talents of children, pupils, and pupils with disabilities in the community. The scheme is tailored to enable beneficiaries to access the basic education possible. DAF will contribute to improving access and better quality of learning through four strategic focus areas namely:

- Organizing free annual holiday coaching for both primary and secondary school students in the community.
- Free distribution of practice questions and answers material for students preparing for WAEC, NECO, and JAMB.
- Organizing free examination coaching for students preparing for WAEC, NECO, and JAMB.
- Purchasing examination forms for the less privileged.

Additionally, DAF aims to also collaborate with a career advancement organization to host a career development series. Topics that would be covered include:

- CV analysis.
- Career planning.
- Knowing yourself and using that knowledge to set career goals; and
- Study abroad.

### **Community Medical Outreach**

DAF offers to set up free mobile medical testing centers on a quarterly basis to provide free health services to individuals who lack access to basic healthcare.

As we are committed to the belief that access to affordable healthcare is a basic human necessity, our aim is to bridge the gap in health care accessibility by providing primary health care to fit the medical needs of the uninsured. Through the specialized skills and generosity of our medical professional volunteers, we hope to deliver free health services to underserved populations who have fallen through the cracks of the healthcare system within the community where we serve.

### **Small Scale Community Trade Initiatives**

DAF seeks to invest in grassroot and small-sized businesses, and promote local economic development, through a com-

munity-led development approach in the form of financial grants to early-stage entrepreneurs particularly women and youth. DAF also seeks to provide farmers with grants, and relief in the form of providing agricultural equipment, fertilizers, etc.

## **Youth Empowerment Programmes**

DAF seeks to partner with local organizations in the emerging market, and other change-makers, to encourage economic opportunities for at least 20 youths annually through vocational training such as Computer Literacy training, Beautician, fashion designing, Sewing, Handicraft, Handbag making, Catering, Bakery products, and Photography.
